

Current Covid-19 Protocol

Updated Mask Protocol

We are constantly monitoring Covid-19 and the Delta Variant and making decisions to best protect our dancers and their families. As we have throughout the entire pandemic, we are going to continue to follow the recommendations and guidance set forth by state and local governments. Effective for our Fall Schedule, **all individuals ages 4 & up (dancers, staff, family members, etc.) are required to wear a mask when indoors at CORE Dance.** This is the best way to protect our children who are currently ineligible to get vaccinated.

Additional Covid-19 Protocol

-We will leave the large garage doors open for maximum airflow during all classes in both Studio 1 and Studio 3. Classes in Studio 2 have been limited to a lower number of students to allow for social distancing and squares have been taped off to give each dancer their own space to move in.

-Dressing rooms are open only for dancers to drop their bags off and pick them up on the way to and from dance class. There is no congregating allowed in the dressing rooms, dancers should wait outside until it is time for class to begin.

-Lobbies, ballet barres, bathrooms and all other high traffic areas will be disinfected twice per day and a deep clean of the studio is being done twice per week.

-Hand sanitizer is available at the front desk and in each dance studio.

Exciting New Renovations!

Over the summer we have been working hard to update our space and give it some needed improvements. We have installed new Marley Flooring in Studio 1, expanded the sprung dance flooring and applied a fresh coat of paint in Studio 3. We are both excited about our new space and eager to protect it. **We will no longer be allowing dancers to enter the dance room from the garage doors as it tracks dirt into the studio that puts holes in the flooring.** Keep reading below for specific instructions on how to enter each dance studio while helping us keep our space tidy. Dancers should always wear their street shoes into the lobby areas and change into their dance shoes indoors before entering the dance room. **ABSOLUTELY NO STREET SHOES ARE ALLOWED ON THE DANCE FLOOR.**

Options for Parents Viewing Class

In the past we have set up a handful of chairs outside of both Studio 1 & Studio 3 for parents to view class. **We absolutely still invite/allow parents to watch but request you bring your own folding/portable chair if you would like to sit down.** We now need those chairs in our viewing area for families with young dancers in Studio 2 and will no longer be setting them up each day as it tracks dirt onto our new flooring.

How to enter the Studio on the First Day

1. Make sure you and your dancer(s) have their mask on prior to entering CORE Dance.
2. Please check in with the Front Desk if you need assistance on which studio to go to for class.
3. How to enter each studio (teachers & staff will be there to assist on the first day):

If your class is in Studio 1: dancers, please enter through the main entrance (past the front desk) and have your dancer place their water bottle, dance bag, shoes, etc. in the main lobby area under a bench. Dancers will continue through the hallway to enter Studio 1 after changing into their dance shoes. *No street shoes are allowed on the dance floor unless they are clean tennis shoes for Hip Hop. These shoes should NOT be the same ones worn daily.* Parents are allowed to bring a chair from home and observe class from outside the large garage door but should avoid congregating in the lobby area to avoid crowding.

If your class is in Studio 2: dancers, please enter through the main entrance (past the front desk) and have your dancer place their water bottle, dance bag, shoes, etc. in the main lobby area under a bench. Dancers will continue through the hallway and turn right to enter Studio 2 (the smaller studio) after changing into their dance shoes and find a square to start class in. Parents with dancers under the age of 7 are able to sit in the lobby and observe classes in Studio 2 as long as they have a mask on.

If your class is in Studio 3: please enter through the Pink & Black store and turn left to enter the lobby. Have your dancer place their water bottle, dance bag, shoes, etc. in the main lobby area in a cubby or under a bench. Dancers will continue through the doors at the opposite side of the lobby to enter Studio 3 for class.

****Lobby and dressing room areas are for storing additional shoes and dance bags, NOT for dancers to hang out and congregate.**

Teachers will be taking attendance in class, there is no need for everyone to check in at the front desk (this will help avoid excessive crowding). The front desk will send you an email or call you if we have a billing issue that needs to be resolved.
